The induction program ended with a session on the Need for Research in Psychology which was held on 8th August 2023. Mr. Meet Shinde was invited as the speaker. He is an experienced researcher and an Assistant Professor at Smt. P. N. Doshi Women's College.

He began the session by putting forth a few questions like why did the students choose Counseling Psychology as their specialization and what was the one thing that interested them the most. He then divided students into four groups and asked them to discuss. Based on their answers, he spoke about how crucial research is to the field and highlighted the overlap of skills required to be a researcher and a counselor. The class also watched a video on "The Dangers of a Single Story" and discussed the importance of acknowledging multiple narratives. He concluded the session by discussing a few researches conducted by him and his colleagues.
