7.1.9 - Sensitization of students and employees of the institution to constitutional obligations: values, rights, duties and responsibilities of citizens:

Constitution Day or Samvidhan Diwas is celebrated annually in India on 26 November. The day is also known as National Law Day. The day commemorates the adoption of the Constitution in India. On this day in 1949, the Constituent Assembly of India formally adopted the Constitution of India that came into force on 26 January 1950.

The aim of celebrating this day is to sensitize volunteers about the significance of the Indian Constitution. This year Constitution Day was celebrated via Digital Media as well as the Physical mode" due to this Pandemic situation.
