About the Institution

Smt. Maniben M. P. Shah Women's College of Arts & Commerce (Autonomous) is a premier educational institution located in the heart of Mumbai Metropolis. The motto of our institution is the empowerment of women through quality education and to lay the foundation for progressive and prosperous future of the girl students making them self-reliant and bν responsible homemakers. To fulfil this objective, we provide various academic programmes to almost 6000 students through our Junior College (Affiliated to HSC Board), Degree colleges and Post Graduate Departments (Autonomous under SNDT Women's University).

Our college has been doing consistently well since its inception and has recently been awarded "B++" Grade with cumulative grade point of 2.88/4 from NAAC (National Assessment & Accreditation Council). The college has received a good amount of financial assistance through UGC since it was identified as a college having the potential for excellence (CPE). Utilizing this grant we have further developed our infrastructure and introduced many skill development programmes for students

which can make them self-reliant. College was adjudged as Best College of S.N.D.T. Women's University for the year 2017 – 2018. College received autonomous status from UGC which has been implemented from June 2019.

Highlights of 2022-2023

- The Research Centre "Manthan" was inaugurated by Prof. Ujwala Chakradeo, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Shreemati Nathibai Damodar Thackersey Women's University, on October 04, 2022. Principal, Dr. Leena Raje while expressing rationale behind establishing the centre said that the Centre has been an initiative of the institution under Autonomy to foster research among teachers and students, to generate interest and provide researchers the resources needed for undertaking research.
- Dr. Leena Raje, Principal, superannuated on October 31, 2022, after a long and successful career. Dr. Archana Patki took charge as the IC-Principal from November 01, 2022.
- Dr Usha Mishra, Head Department of Hindi and Dr Daksha Dave, Department of Economics were promoted as Professors on 16th June 2022.
- The 3rd volume of expert reviewed PG Research E Journal "In Quest" was released in December 2022. The compilation includes 12 research papers of MA (Counselling Psychology and Hindi) and M Com students.
- Intercollegiate Research Conclave "Media Conquers: Transforming contents through the lens of Digitalization" was organised by the PG department of Mass Media on April

- 08, 2023. Of the 22 paper presentations, 3 best papers were awarded prizes.
- The 5th volume of "Concept" a peer-reviewed research journal of the college, was released in April 2023.
- 3 Issues of Volume IX of "Beacon" a publication of the Department of Psychology and one issue of Volume X of "Meteor", a publication of the Department of Management Studies, was released in 2022-23.
- The Second Degree Award Ceremony under Autonomy was organised on March 11, 2023. Dr Sangeeta Ravat, Dean, Seth G. S. Medical College & K.E.M Hospital, presided over the programme and presented degrees to our students.
- The "Marathi Bhasha Pandhrawada" was celebrated by the Department of Marathi from January 14, 2023 to January 28, 2023. Several activities such as guest lectures, workshops, poetry recitation, etc were organised therein.
