# Progress of the Criteria-Wise Plan of the Institution for this Semester was presented by Dr. Raje.

Some of the important highlights of the progress report that were shared were as follows:

- CBCS structure to be ready by 15th June and presented in the next Academic Council. Along with some other pre-approved courses, Women and Law, Essentials of Life Management and Universal Human Values will become part of the CBCS courses.
- Examination conduction and Evaluation is being strengthened as per the needs of autonomy. Departments are motivated to use innovative methods for continuous internal evaluations.
- To improve academic performance of the students their learning levels will be tested using a psychological test and implemented through AAC.
- The Research Centre will be activated from the coming academic year. 11 minor research projects will be completed by May end.
- To increase Library usage and encourage reading habits among students, the library has taken initiative to conduct activities such as online quiz competition and book review competition. Sessions on IPR, Speed reading, memory techniques will be conducted.
- The Academic Advancement Center will gear up for enhancement of students' academic performance by arranging short duration/bridge/remedial courses. Mentoring process will be formalised and given a proper structure.
- Institution has signed MOU's with LearNet Skills, NIIT Foundation, TechnoServe India, Trade School-BSE, CFX etc to make our students job ready in fields such as data entry back office, Banking and Financial Services, Accounting, Auditing and Banking.
- To inculcate skills in students and make them job ready, add-On programmes in Tally GST, Advance Excel, Digital Marketing, Spoken English and Personality Development are being offered on a continuous basis.
- To foster entrepreneurship, Innovation and Incubation Centre is offering practical training to students in various areas such as party starters, sandwiches, chocolates, jewellery making etc. Further training for packing, labelling and pricing will be arranged.
- Process of Alumni Registration will be completed in the next 2 months.
- The Staff and Students Module in ACADMiN Software integrated in the system will be adopted effectively by the teachers from the next academic year.
- Revised Vision-Mission statement will be set by the beginning of the new academic year.
- Institution has signed an MOU with Threco- E- waste recycling company on 26<sup>th</sup> April 2022 and will initiate e-waste collection through them.
- Workshop Series on Human Values has been an ongoing activity and it will be planned next to cover maximum no. of students
- Green Audit was conducted on 30th April by Dr. Rajshekar Patil, an educationalist and environmentalist for Audit work, the compliance report has been shared by the college.
