ABOUT OUR COLLEGE

Smt. Maniben M. P. Shah Women's College of Arts and Commerce was established in year 1957 with 7 students and it is the first college affiliated to SNDT Women's University. It is managed by Seva Mandal Education Society (SMES). The motto of our institution is empowerment of women through quality in education and to lay foundation for progressive and prosperous future of the girl students by making them self-reliant and responsible homemakers. BRIEF HISTORY OF OUR N.S.S. UNIT

Our NSS Unit is established in 1970 with 5 NSS Volunteer under the leadership of our Management, Principal Dr. DhairayabalaVora and NSS Programme Officer

Mrudulaben Shah. The junior college NSS Unit started in 1996. Today our NSS Unit has 300 degree college volunteers and 100 junior college volunteers. There are 3 Programme Officers (POs) from the degree college and 2 POs from junior college.

The College is situated in centre of Mumbai and in close proximity to Asia's largest slum community at Dharavi. Other slum pockets like the Antophill area, Guru Tej Bahadur Nagar and Wadala Gate no. 4. Our college offers services through social work in these neighbourhoods. Our students residing in these areas also benefit from the outreach programmes carried out by the NSS Unit in these areas. Our Management, Principal and teachers actively take part in collaborating with various NGOs to conduct extension activities. NSS motto is Not Me But You and our NSS Unit is proud of the fact that along with regular NSS volunteers a number of alumni are still associated and contribute to all NSS regular activities and special camp. Regular NSS activities include voter awareness, tree plantation, medical check-up camps, awareness rallies for gender sensitization , anti-smoking , anti-alcoholism, anti-drugs, AIDS awareness and so on , blood donation camp, freeship and notebook distribution. A few significant activities include adoption of slum community at Wadala Gate no. 4 in the college neighborhood, King's Circle Railway Station and Mammoli village in Thane district. These adoption have been approved by SNDT Women's University under Munijjan Yojana of Government of India, station Master King's Circle station and Gram Panchayat of Mammoli village respectively. In all three adopted areas NSS works towards enabling of the community through awareness activities and skill building activities for socio - economic empowerment. Through these activities our students have benefited in many ways – all round personality development, leadership quality, value education, team building and team work , caring, sharing, understanding other views and respecting them , confidence building and identifying with the cultural and traditional diversity of the country and creating the consciousness towards nation building .

SPECIAL PROJECT –MUTTHI ANAAJ DAAN

The simple and highly fruitful concept MAKE A DIFFERENCE through MUTTHI ANAAJ DAAN (M.A.D) is a thought first came to a group of enthusiastic young group of friends who wanted to Make A Difference for the underprivileged. With

basic maths and other related technicalities, they chalked up as an effective plan of action. For M.A.D, all one has to do is put a fistful of grain in a plastic jar over the course of a month at home while cooking and hand over to team. That respective contribution is checked, packed and distributed to the people in need. However, careful monitoring is implemented to make sure that the correct MAD process is being practiced. College than take up the responsibility of distributing the collected grains are thoroughly screened along with their accounting books, records of the donors and the recipients. M.A.D. being tied in with education, only those continuing with their education is eligible to benefit with 5 kg rice and 2 kg tur daal every month.

M.A.D got the proverbial boost in May 2014 with a huge contribution by Lions Club of Sion to NSS unit of Smt. M.M.P. Shah Women's College of Arts and Commerce, Matunga towards 125 girls who came from impoverished areas like Dharavi, Sion, Matunga, Kurla and Wadala gate number 4, etc. Number of beneficiary increased since June 2016 from 125 to 250 and from September 2017 five more students included. This year also 300 needy students were benefited in this noble project.

To continue the services during vacation the N.S.S unit plans to give them grains before Diwali and summer vacation in advance. So that there is no discontinuation of services.

SHIVSWARAJA DIN DAY CELEBRATION

- The NSS Unit of Smt. Maniben M.P. Shah Women's College of Arts and Commerce had organized the event on 06 June 2022 to celebrate Shivswarajya Din. This historic day of Shiv Rajyabhishek Din was celebrated in Maharashtra to mark the coronation day of the great Maratha warrior king Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj. It was on this day in the year 1674 when Shivaji Maharaj was crowned as the Chhatrapati of the Maratha Kingdom. NSS volunteers, students (Sr. & Jr. college) the teachers and the non-teaching staff all enthusiastically participated in this celebration.
- Shivrajyabhishek Diwas, also known as 'The coronation of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj' is widely celebrated throughout the Maharashtra state on 6th June to commemorate establishment of the 'Maratha Empire'. On June 6, 2022, 'The Shivswarajyabhishek Din Vishesh' Event was organised by N.S.S. Unit. To give tribute to our beloved King Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj.
- The event was held in the Foyer of college premises, where, on this occasion, the venue was decorated with orange flags, Patakas, and garlands signifying culture of Marathas. Volunteers adorned the Shrine of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj with beautiful flowers and garlands adding beauty to the cause. The entire event was divided in three parts.
- The event has been started in the following manner:
- The event started at 11A.M. by Prof. Dr. Rekha Shelar giving welcoming speech and greeting everyone. Principal Dr. Leena Raje inaugurated the event by offering abhivadan to the image of Shivaji Maharaj. Along with that Ms Komal Rampure has sung the song "Jai Jai Maharashtra Majha" to note the tribute the Maharashtra state.
- Dr. Leena Raje (Principal) to give a welcome speech to the crowd and she given the speech on Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj and what kind of warrior he was. She spoken about his innovative military tactics and his administration further she explained his qualities which he possesses as a leader and what helped him to become the king of maratha empire.

- Later the students performed The Royal Entry of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj by announcing ‘Shiv Garjana’ with the Arrival of Maharaj paying tribute to the Shivrajyabhishek ceremony.
- Songs like ‘Aao baccho tumhe sikhaye’, ‘Vedat Marathe veer daudle saat’ were presented in the start of the event by students and Non Teaching Staff celebrating Maratha dynasty and the brave Marathi soldiers.
- Various speeches such as ‘Shivaji Maharajanche Vyaktimatva’ by volunteer Ms. Prerna Chaurse and ‘Shivrajyabhishek Varnan’ by student Ms. Kumud Desai were given describing the King and Coronation ceremony or ‘Abhishek Sohala’ of Shivaji Maharaj.
- A short-film by NSS PO was displayed on screen giving information on significant forts of Maharashtra such as Raigad, Pratapgadh, Panhala etc. To spread glory of the empire and to spread awareness about their declining condition. Encouraging audience to protect this historic witness who stood to the glory of Maratha Samrajya throughout the past and present.
- Later in the event ‘Hirkani’ dance was performed by the student Ms. Tejal Gurav which portrayed the true story of a Brave mother named Hirkani who descended from a terrific cliff of the raigad fort on the night of Rajyabhishek, for her child, which gave audience goosebumps.
- Volunteer Ms. Aparna Kasare performed a speech ‘Mavlyache Manogat’ which targeted political and social issues and comparing it with ‘ShivSvarajya’, through the perspective of ‘Maavla’ soldier of Shivaji Maharaj. Which motivated audience against the odds and evils in the society and to make a better world –‘Surajya’.
- Later student Ms. Priyanka Jogdand conveyed her words through the poetry ‘Mi Shivajiraje Bhosale boltoy’ which narrates the thoughts on the todays social situations by the perspective of Shivaji Maharaj.
- ‘Powadas’ which are poetries performed mainly in maratha culture which narrates the story of the victory and bravery of the king, were presented by students and faculty. Powada ‘Dhanya Dhanya Shivaji Shoor’ by student Ms. Sanjana Patil and group was performed narrating the victory of Shivaji Maharaj over Cruel AfzalKhan, knight of Adilshah. Powada ‘Shoor Aamhi Sardar’ was sung by Office Superintend Mr. Manohar Yadav, celebrating knighthood of Maratha Empire.
- Ms. Ashwini Prabhu, Librarian was sung the song on शतकाच्या यज्ञातून उठली
to narrates the Shivsvrajya Abhishek Sohla.

- In the end of the event, students presented the Dance ‘Shivrajyabhishek Sohala’ portraying crowning ceremony of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj performing folk dances of maharashtra, mesmerizing and joyful.
- After all the performances were done, Principal Dr. Leena Raje admired the efforts of the students and faculties for the event and encouraged them for further progress and such events. The event was concluded with the Thanking note by prof. Seema Gupta to the audience, authorities and organizers of the event and promising such more occasions ahead and National Anthem. 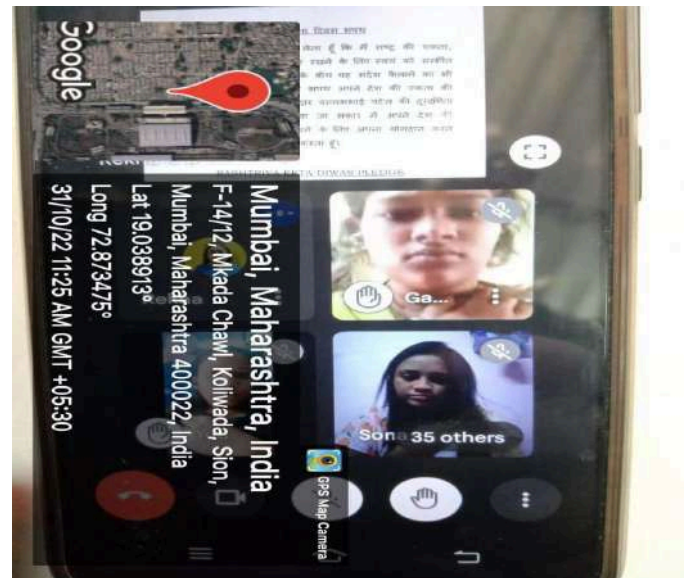
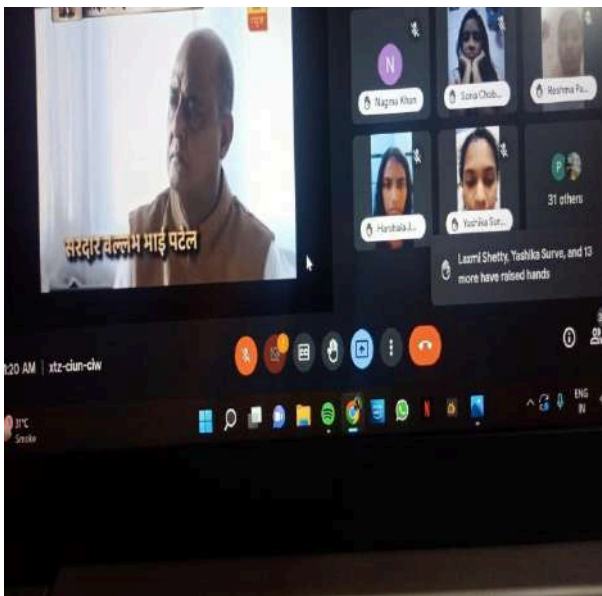




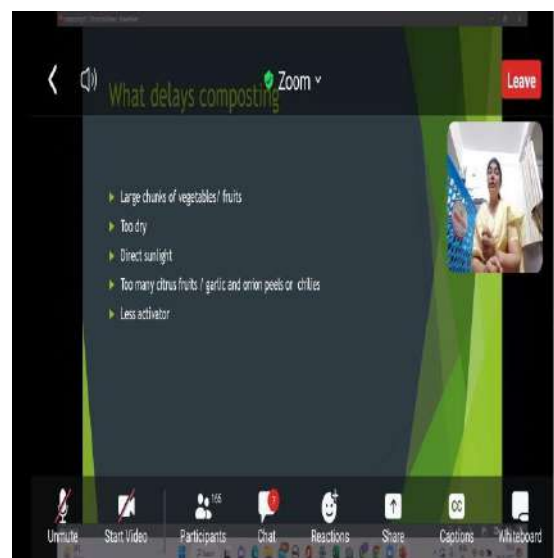
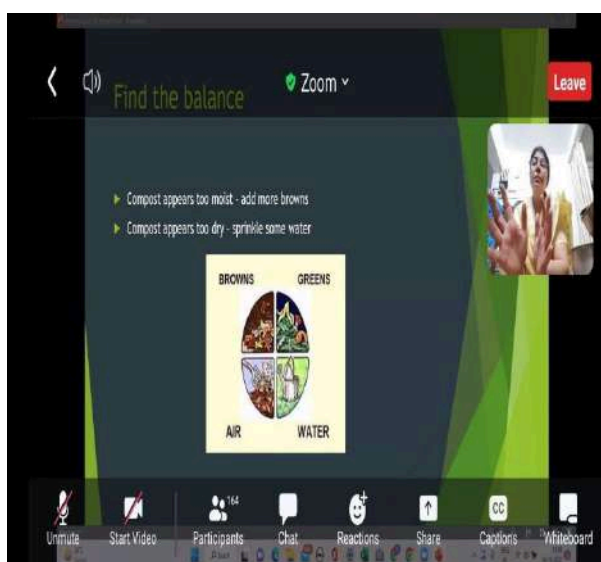
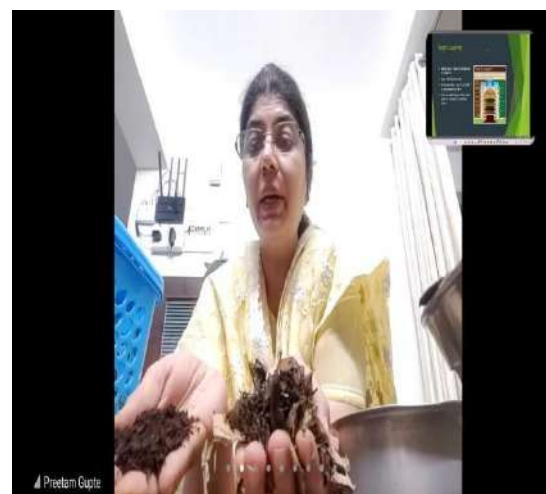
WORKSHOP ON "HOME COMPOSTING AND
