About our college

Smt. Maniben M. P. Shah Women's College of Arts and Commerce was established in year 1957 with 7 students and it is the first college affiliated with SNDT Women's University. It is managed by the Seva Mandal Education Society (SMES). The motto of our institution is empowering women through quality education and laying the foundation for a progressive and prosperous future for female students by making them self-reliant and responsible homemakers. To fulfill the objectives, we provide various academic programs to almost 6000 students through our junior college (affiliated to HSC Board Maharashtra State), Degree College, and Post Graduate Departments (affiliated to SNDT Women's University). College has received a 'B ++' grade from the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). Our institution stands for women's education, and we celebrate 60 years of our commitment to making education available to women from all strata of society. The college has been awarded with UGC Status: College with Potential for Excellence (CPE) in 2016. The college has also received the SNDT WU Best College Award for 2017-2018.

Today we are recognized as an institution with a reputation for creating capable and responsible citizens for our country through quality education.

Brief History of our N.S.S. Unit

Our NSS Unit was established in 1970 with 5 NSS volunteers under the leadership of our Management, Principal Dr. Dhairayabala Vora, and NSS Programme Officer Mrudulaben Shah. The junior college NSS Unit started in 1996. Today our NSS Unit has 300-degree college volunteers and 100 junior college volunteers. There are 3 Programme Officers (POs) from the degree college and 2 POs from the junior college.

The College is situated in the centre of Mumbai and close to Asia's largest slum community at Dharavi. Other slum pockets like the Antophill area, Guru Tej Bahadur Nagar, and Wadala Gate no. 4. Our college offers services through social work in these neighbourhoods. Our students residing in these areas also benefit from the outreach programs carried out by the NSS Unit in these areas. Our Management, Principal, and teachers actively take part in collaborating with various NGOs to conduct extension activities. NSS's motto is Not Me But You and our NSS Unit is proud of the fact that along with regular NSS volunteers, several alumni are still associated and contribute to all NSS regular activities and special camps. Regular NSS activities include voter awareness, tree plantation, medical check-up camps, awareness rallies for gender sensitization, anti-smoking, anti-alcoholism, anti-drugs, AIDS awareness, and so on, blood donation camps, freeship, and notebook distribution. A few significant activities include the adoption of a slum community at Wadala Gate no. 4 in the college neighbourhood, King's Circle Railway Station, and Mammoli village in Thane district. These adoptions have been approved by SNDT Women's University under Munijjan Yojana of the Government of India, station Master King's Circle station, and the Gram Panchayat of Mammoli village respectively. In all three adopted areas, NSS works towards enabling the community through awareness activities and skill-building activities for socio-economic empowerment. Through these activities our students have benefited in many ways – all-round personality development, leadership quality, value education, team building and teamwork, caring, sharing, understanding other views and respecting them, confidence building, and identifying with the cultural and traditional diversity of the country and creating the consciousness towards nation building.

Special Project – Mutthi Anaaj Daan

The simple and highly fruitful concept MAKE A DIFFERENCE through MUTTHI ANAAJ DAAN (M.A.D) is a thought that first came to a group of an enthusiastic young group of friends who wanted to Make a Difference for the underprivileged. With basic maths and other related technicalities, they chalked up as an effective plan of action. For M.A.D., all one has to do is put a fistful of grain in a plastic jar over a month at home while cooking and hand it over to the team. That respective contribution is checked, packed, and distributed to the people in need. However, careful monitoring is implemented to make sure that the correct MAD process is being practiced. Colleges that take up the responsibility of distributing the collected grains are thoroughly screened along with their accounting books, and records of the donors and the recipients. M.A.D. being tied in with education, only those continuing with their education are eligible to benefit with 5 kg rice and 2 kg tur daal every month.

M.A.D got the proverbial boost in May 2014 with a huge contribution by the Lions Club of Sion to the NSS unit of Smt. M.M.P. Shah Women's College of Arts and Commerce, Matunga towards 125 girls who came from impoverished areas like Dharavi, Sion, Matunga, Kurla, and Wadala gate number 4, etc. The number of beneficiaries increased since June 2016 from 125 to 250 and from September 2017 five more students were included. This year also 300 needy students were benefited from this noble project.

To continue the services during vacation the N.S.S unit plans to give them grains before Diwali and summer vacation in advance. So that there is no discontinuation of services.

May Summer Camp

Summer camp offers children the chance to foster independence, build confidence, socialize, make friends, and learn new things.

Objectives

The objectives of the camp were:

1. To expose the NSS volunteers to rurality (RURAL-REALITY), and its challenges
2. To understand the rural issues and engage them with Swachhta and other activities.
3. To facilitate the personal growth and social skills of NSS volunteers
4. Identify the needs and problems of the community and involve them in the problem-solving process.
5. Develop among themselves a sense of social and civic responsibility.
6. Utilize their knowledge in finding practical solutions to individual and community problems.

NCC and NSS Unit collaborated with Mumbai Smile to organize a summer camp from May 2nd to May 8th, 2023 in Vanicha Pada, Aarey Colony at Goregaon East.

Day 1 - 2nd May 2023

The summer camp was inaugurated by Principal Dr. Archana Patki, NSS zonal coordinator Renuka Prajapati, Lt. Suvarna Joshi, and Mumbai Smile organization members. 59 children participated in jogging, running, slow walking, and stretching exercises. The "Mumbai Smiles" organization gave a lecture on "Human Trafficking". The Psychology Department divided children into age groups and played educational games. The session ended with singing songs, including 'Hum Honge Kamyab Ek Din'.

Day 2 – 3rd May 2023

Lt. Suvarna Joshi led a warm-up session for 38 children, dividing them into two groups for games. The younger children participated in a running race and a Maharashtrian game called "Mama ch Patra Haravla." They introduced themselves in English, with some needing help. The older children played wrestling and backflips, becoming more confident after learning techniques. The NSS Unit delivered a lecture on setting goals, career options, and having a strong plan. The children learned "Itni Shakti Hame Dena Data" and shared Sachin Tendulkar's inspiring life story.

Day 3 – 4th May 2023

The session focused on children's artistic skills in drawing and painting. Renuka ma'am introduced Pada and its development, while Lt. Suvarna Joshi led a warm-up session. The children played games, with younger ones playing 'Sunday-Monday' and 'Passing the Handkerchief', and older ones playing 'Dog and Bone'. After lunch, they were given freedom to draw various images, including houses, landscapes, flowerpots, mountains, and seas. Some

struggling children were assisted by their peers. Art supplies were provided, and the children sang a song taught by the NSS Volunteers, "Itni Shakti Hame Dena Data."

Day 4 – 5th May 2023

The children participated in various physical activities led by Lt. Suvarna Joshi, including warm-up exercises, games like "Hold the Pole" and "Khamb-Khamb-Khambodi," and a distance running race. They learned Kho-Kho and Lezim dance, a prominent art form in Maharashtra. The children were divided into two groups: younger children played 'Passing the Ball', while older children played 'Kho-Kho'. After lunch, Lt. Suvarna Joshi taught the elder children how to play lezim. Later, they played Kabaddi and sang a song taught by the NSS Volunteers. Hanuman Chalisa was also taught to each child.

Mrs. Renuka Prajapati, NSS Zonal Coordinator, Dr. Rekha Shelar, and Ms. Soni Singh visited the Vanicha Pada to interact with the women. They expressed issues related to health, employment, and education, and how the children of the pada are unable to continue their studies due to inadequate education resources and their low-income status.

Day 5 – 6th May 2023

The activities focused on balance, quilling, waste management, and Lezim, a popular art in Maharashtra. Lt. Suvarna Joshi led a warm-up session for 38 children, who then received a CRAFT lesson from the Sociology Department. They learned how to create simple flowers using Quill Paper. After lunch, the children continued playing Lezim, then learned how to make a pen stand using a plastic bottle. They also sang a song from the NSS Department and learned the 'Hanuman Chalisa'. The session ended with lunch and interaction with the cadets before returning home.

Day 6 – 7th May 2023

Tribal women and girls were educated about personal hygiene during their menstrual cycle through activities led by ANO Lt. Suvarna Joshi and the DAF Foundation. They learned about maintaining cleanliness and the consequences of neglecting their care. The DAF Foundation and NSS volunteers taught children about brushing teeth, dental hygiene, and games like 'Three-Legged Race'. After lunch, the DAF Foundation gave a lecture on menstrual health awareness, emphasizing the importance of personal hygiene for both young girls and married women. They also cleared up myths about menstrual health. A Q&A round was conducted, and Stayfree sanitary napkins were distributed to promote menstrual hygiene. The children also learned how to use sanitary napkins and why. The session concluded with children singing two songs from the NSS Unit

Day 7 – 8th May 2023

The NSS Unit conducted activities to educate young people about the importance of education and good & bad touch. They held a drawing competition, hurdle race, and street play to discuss the concept. The activities highlighted the negative impact of inappropriate touch on women and girls, as well as the harmful effects of alcohol, tobacco, and smoking on young people's health. Cadets cleared doubts about good and bad touch, and children performed Lezim. They also taught children a song called "Itni Shakti Hame Dena Data" and shared lunch with them before returning home. The activities aimed to raise awareness about the harmful effects of these habits on future generations.

During the valedictory function on the final day, children were presented with gifts based on their interests and hobbies. During the event, the NSS PO emphasized the significance of social work and encouraged everyone to contribute to a good cause in their lives. Additionally, she extended a formal vote of thanks to all the participants.

Outcome :

- NSS Volunteers developed unity, team spirit, discipline, and patience through participation in various camp activities.
- The session brought up a new side of the volunteers, in which their imaginative and creative abilities shone brighter
- Eradicated social taboos and myths regarding menstruation
- The proper way to use and dispose of sanitary napkins.
- This helped women and girls adapt to the modern outlook and change their lives regarding menstrual hygiene by realizing its importance.

MARINE ECOSYSTEM AND POLLUTION

5th June 2023, on the Occasion of World Environment Day NSS Unit of Smt. Maniben M. P Shah Women's College has organized an awareness session by an expert on "Marine Ecosystem and Pollution". Environment Day is celebrated to raise awareness and encourage global action for the protection of our environment. The Eminent Resource was Mr. Swanand Gawde. The session started with a welcome address by Principal Dr. Archana Patki. After That Guest speaker explained the Marine Ecosystem and Coastal Diversity of Mumbai, he also explained the sources of marine diversity, and effects of Plastic Pollution on Marine life, and what precautions to take to avoid pollution. He showed the small video clip to Awareness of environmental issues. He promotes the conservation of marine ecology and reducing plastic waste in our oceans, before the session, sir sends a Pre-test and after the session, he sends Post post-test also. The session was attended by 35 NSS Volunteers, 3 NSS PO along with, and 3 teachers attend the session.

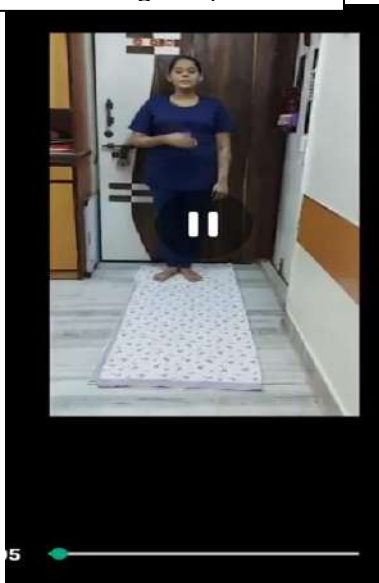

Besides these posters making & slogan competition was organized to focus on the benefits of yoga, The best 3 posters were selected by the guests & certificates were awarded to the winners.



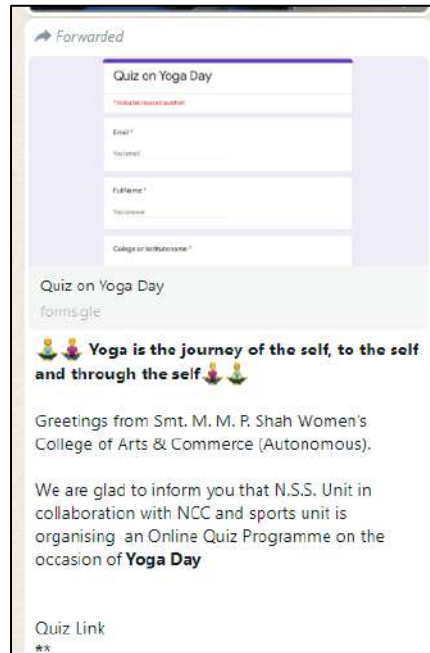

WORLD POPULATION DAY

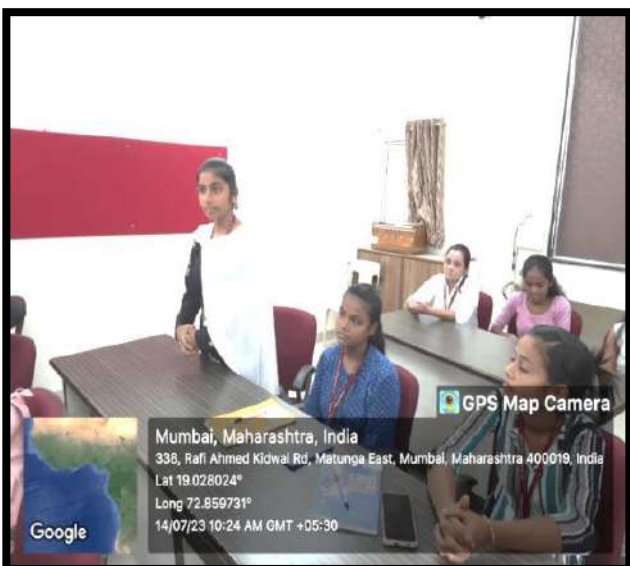

VISITED AT ADOPTED AREA MAMNOLI

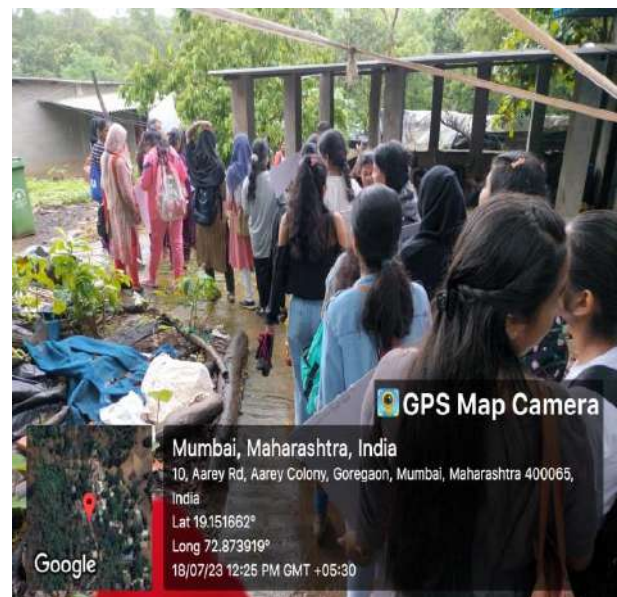

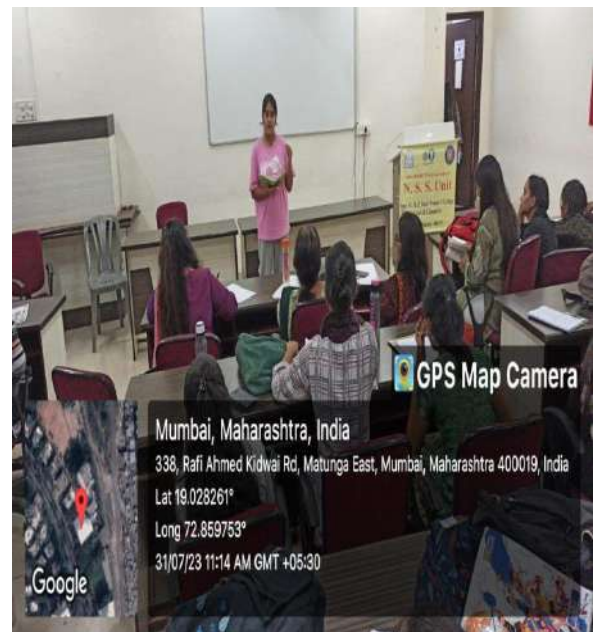
E-WASTE MANAGEMENT

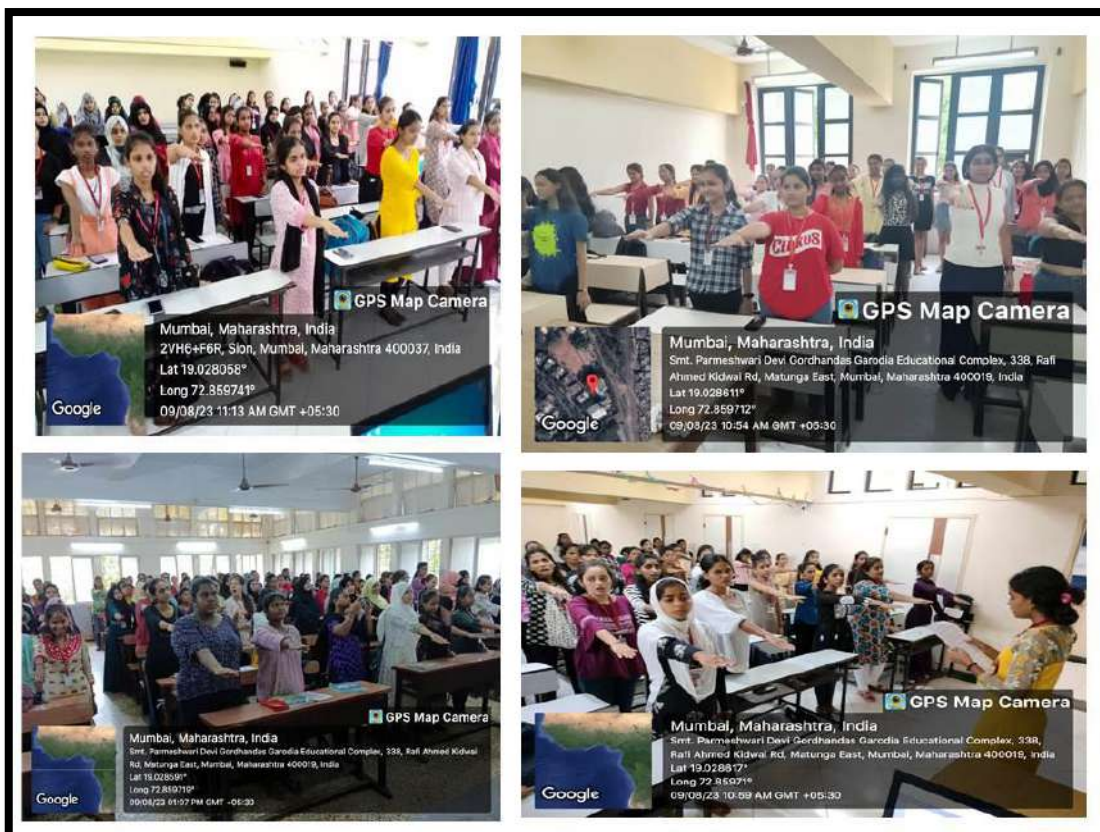
REPORT OF “MERI MAATI MERA DESH”

- Inspire the youth population of the country during Amrit Kaal to direct their youth power in the direction of 'India@2047' as a Global Leader.

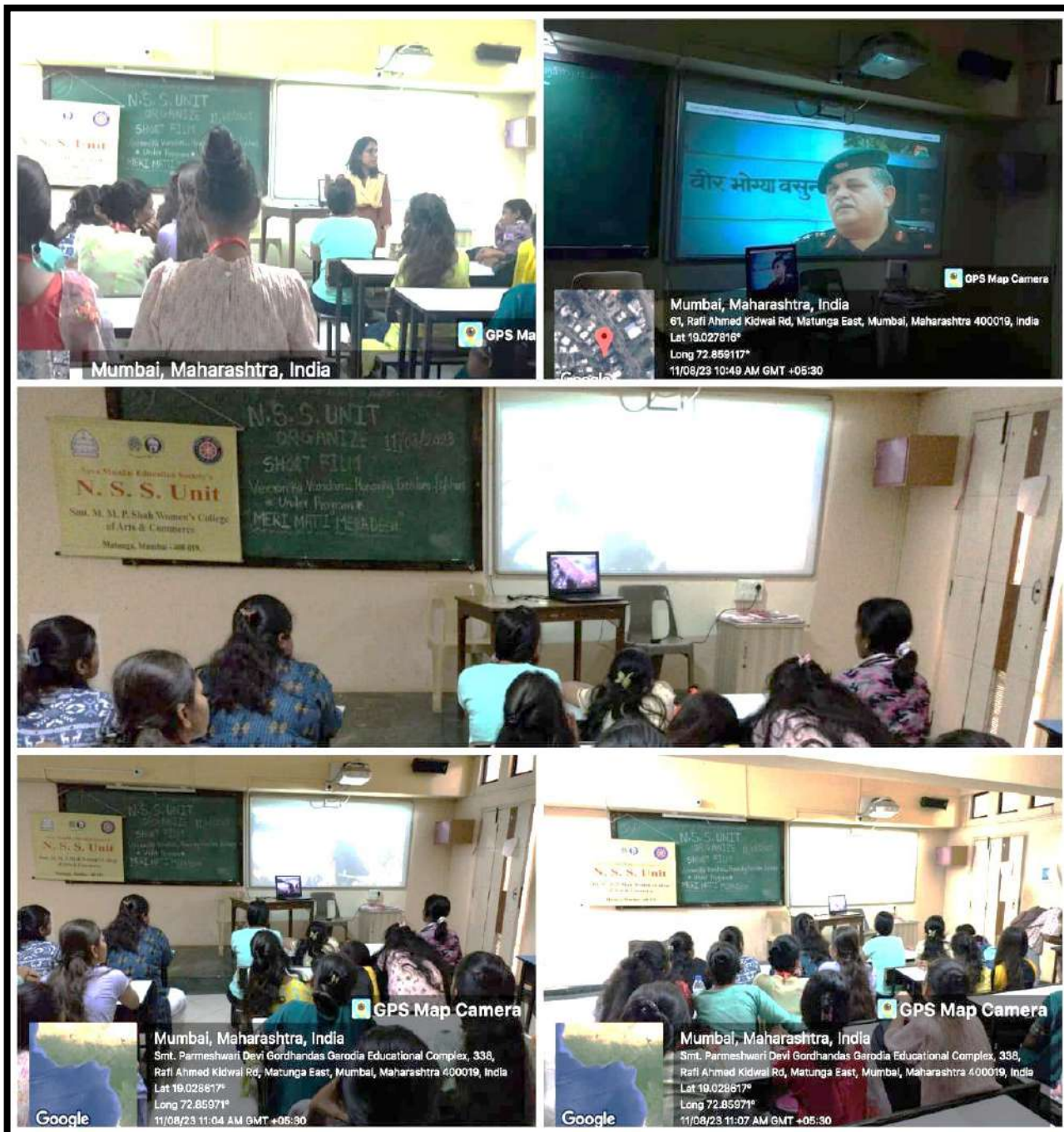

GUEST LECTURE

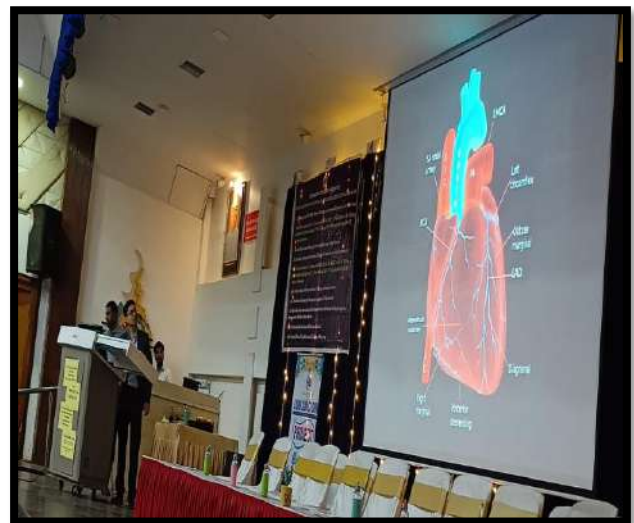

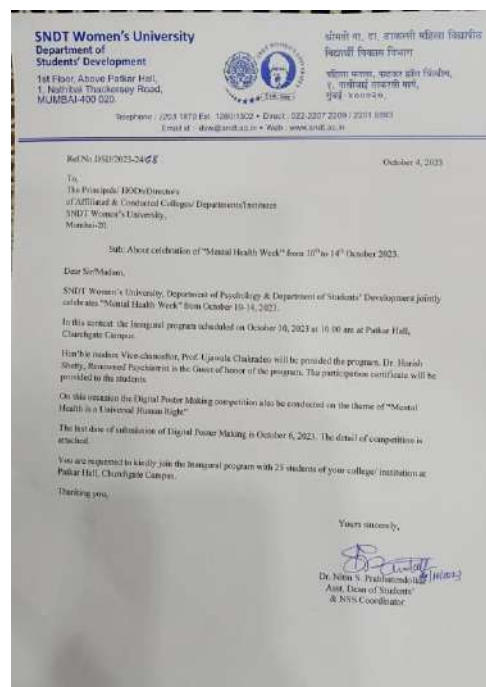

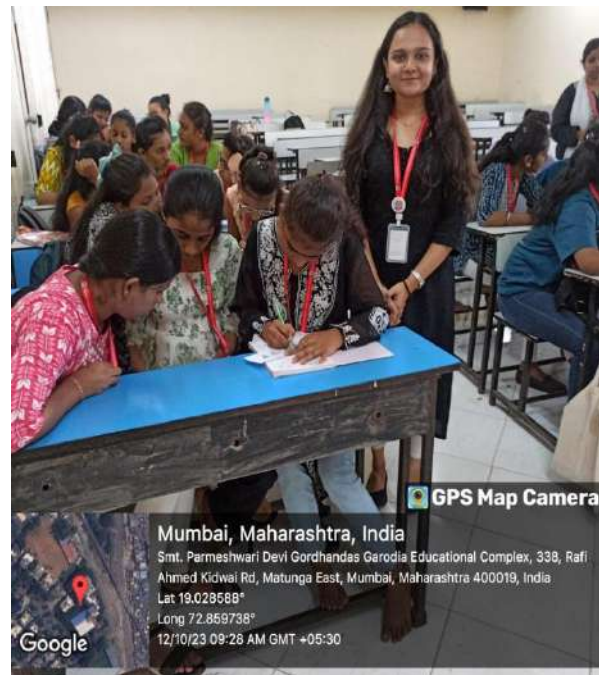
MENTAL HEALTH WEEK CELEBRATION

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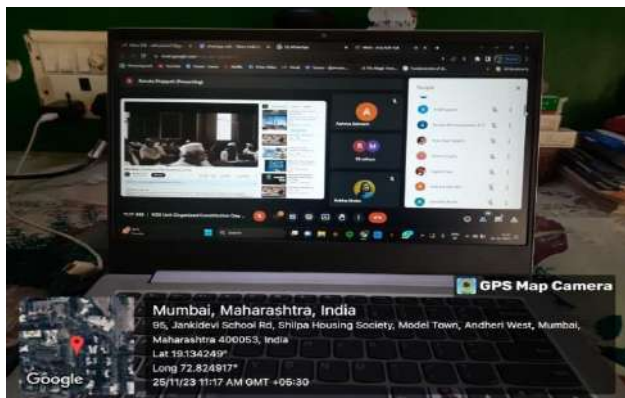
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CONSTITUTION DAY

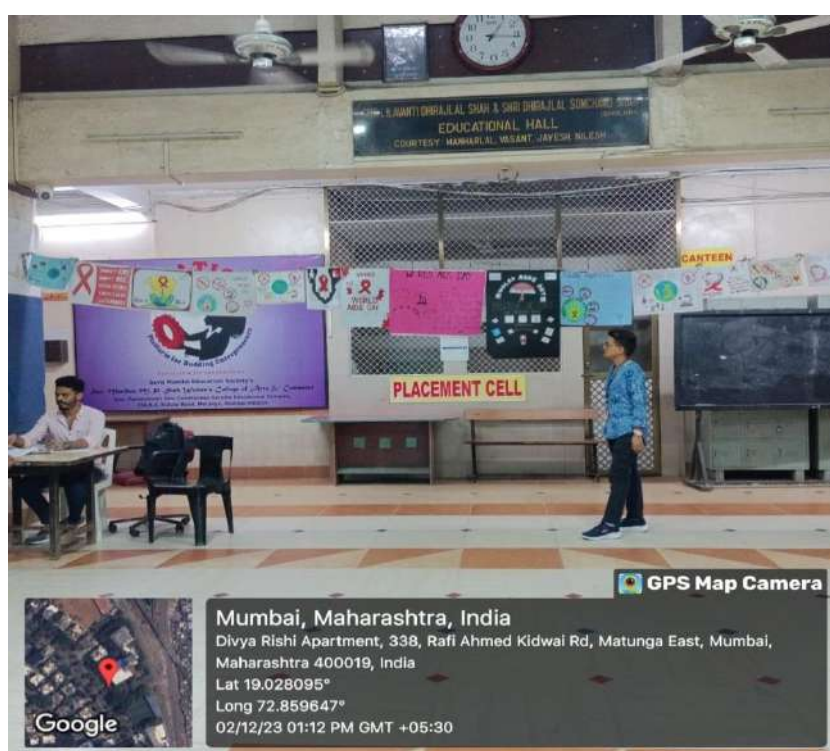
WORLD AIDS AWARENESS DAY

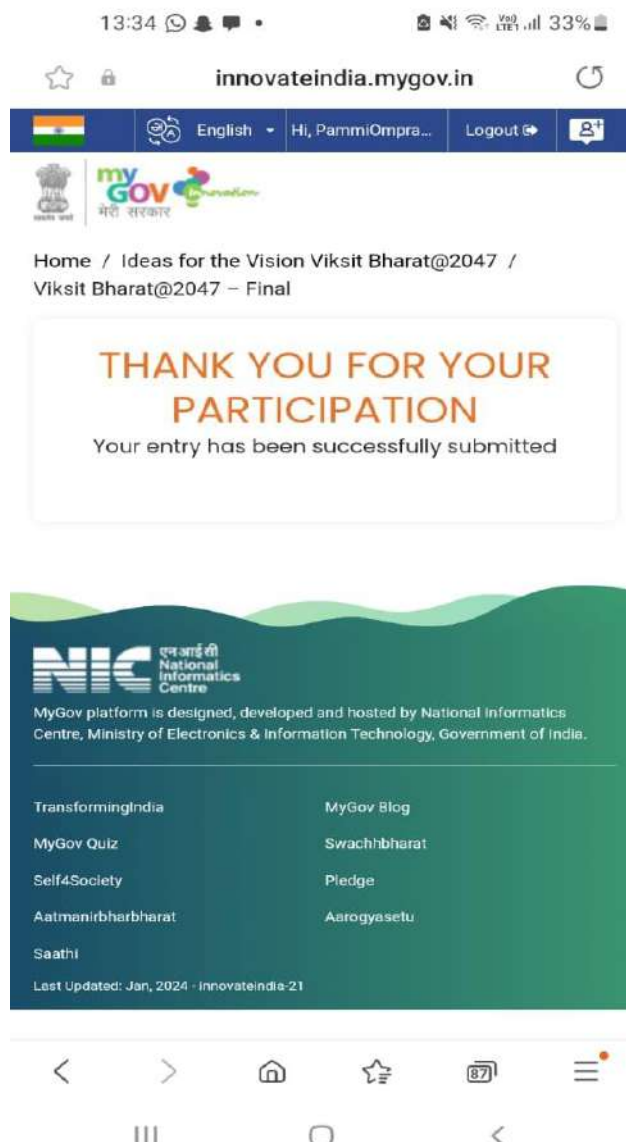


SHARE YOUR IDEAS FOR VIKSIT BHARAT

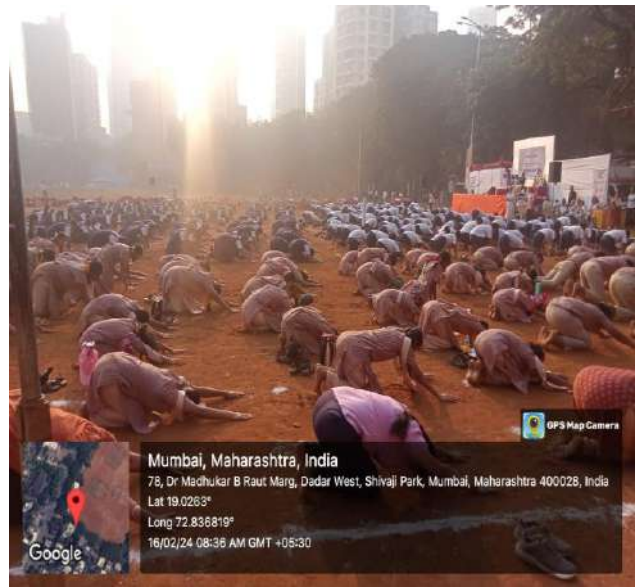
BLOOD DONATION

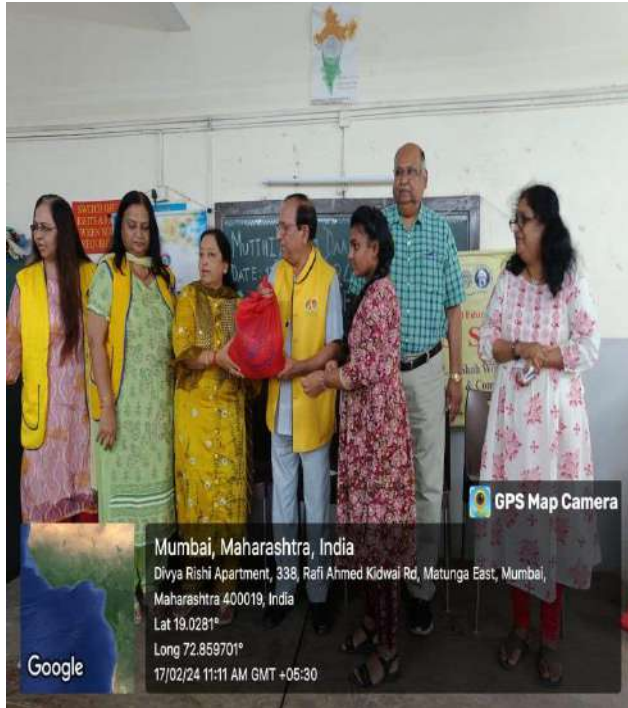
SURYA NAMASKAR MAHAYAGYA EVENT

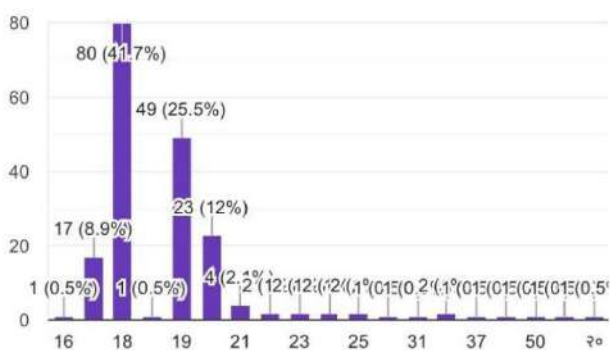

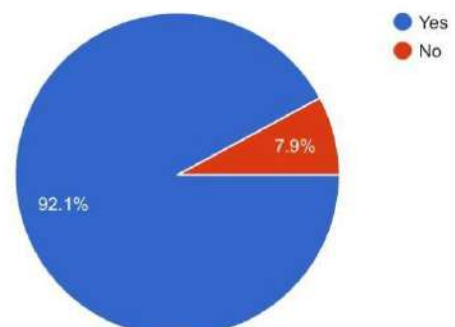

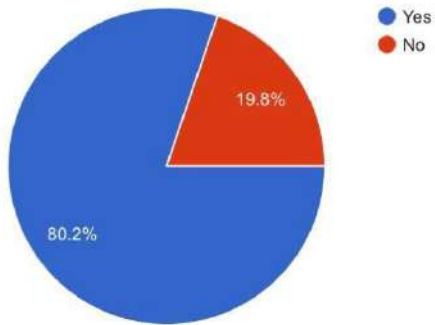
Are you aware about voting?

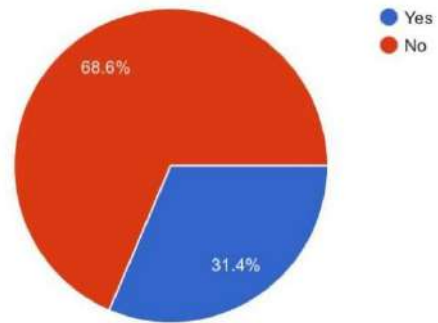
Are you above 18 years?

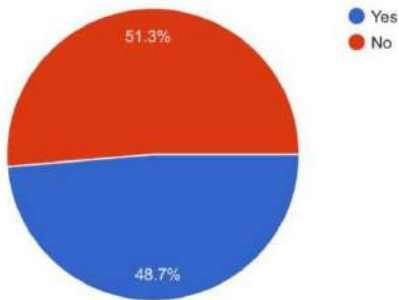
Do you have a voting card?

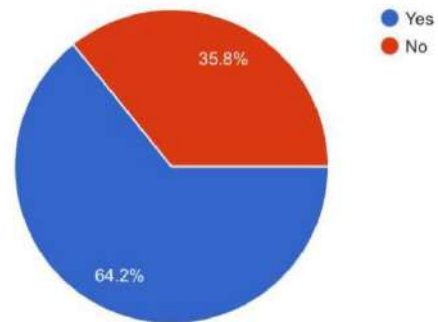
Have you applied for a voting card if you don't have one?

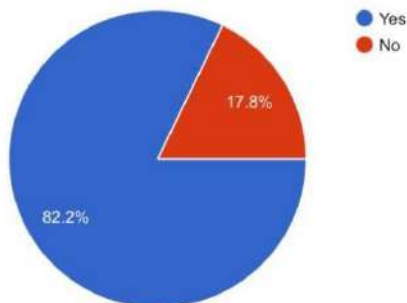
Are you going to vote?
