YUVA Mahotsav Finale September 2024 Report

Smt. Maniben M. P. Shah Women's College of Arts And Commerce co-hosted the SNDT Women's University inter-collegiate festival "YUVA Mahotsav" on the 20th and the 21st of September, 2024. It is a festival filled with art, culture, literature and vibrant glimpses of the rich cultural heritage of India that the university has been organising since its inception.

Inauguration

The festival began with the inaugural function on the 20th September, 2024 at 9:30 am, at Visanji Ravji Auditorium, with Ganesh vandana for invoking the blessings of Lord Ganesha. This was followed by the University song. 
